Purpose

Scholarship Types & Amounts

Oklahoma State University, Institute of Technology School of Diesel and Heavy Equipment: Full tuition and tool scholarship to Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology in Okmulgee, Oklahoma.

Kansas/Nebraska Community or Technical College: Scholarship for \$2,000 per semester to an approved community or technical college in Kansas or Nebraska (see list), plus a \$1,000 voucher to purchase tools from KanEquip at a discount.
