Revenue Neutral Tax Rate Hearing:

Kurt Brown informed the board of education that the district would not be exceeding the RNR for fund year 2026.

Information Report:

RNR Hearing ended at 7:40 pm.

Budget Hearing:

Budget Code 99 of the school district was reviewed. Kurt Brown provided assessment data of the educational needs of both attendance centers in the district. The board evaluated the needs and used recommendations to finalize the budget. Fund Cash Balances and the annual LOB percentage resolution were reviewed.

AD Report:

John Crist gave the AD Report. Fall sports numbers: HS football-15; HS volleyball-21; HS boys cross country-11; HS girls cross country-7; JH football-16; JH volleyball-20; JH girls cross country-0; JH boys cross country-5. Football districts for the next two years will come out in October. Storage building for the football field was discussed.

Donation: Athletic donation for \$45.00 from By a Thread - Allison Gehiring. Shane will attend the KASB Convention on November 14-16 in Wichita. The board reviewed bid specs for an in ground sprinkler system for football fields. HS parking lot construction area repair was discussed. Mr. Brown will visit with DCS on costs and what will be reimbursed by vendors.

The lobby floor is complete, but the transition from the new lobby to existing flooring is not complete. Concessions will be open for this week's activities, but the outside entrance will not be ready due to railing not being installed. October meeting will be held at the HS so a tour can be done on construction.
